SUBJECT: WPL Registration of 22 Players – DEADLINE March 5, 2008

Women's Premier League clubs are reminded that they must have 22 players registered by March 5, 2008.

Any clubs who fail to meet the deadline for the 22 players may be relegated to Women's State League 2, as outlined in Section 2.2.5 in the Women's Rules of Competition.

(a) In 2008, each Womens' Premier League Club shall register a minimum of 22 players by no later than 5pm Wednesday, 5th March 2008.

(b) Failure to comply may result in the Club forfeiting its position in the Women's Premier League competition in which case each defaulting Club will be relegated to Women's State League Division 2 or below.

(c) If a vacancy arises in Women's State League Division 1, FFV may make that position available to such relegated Club, if FFV is satisfied that the required amount of players will be registered by the commencement of the season
