



The All Communities Project – Ballarat



Through the VicHealth PICSAR funding, Football Federation Victoria (FFV) has been granted the chance to work with the Ballarat Community over the next four years. Our aim is to provide opportunities for newly arrived refugees and members of CALD communities to participate in football. Participation includes both direct participation, i.e. playing and indirect opportunities such as coaching, refereeing and administration. Our target is juniors through to seniors across both genders.

While the All Communities project may focus on increasing participation, it also aims to empower FFV and its partners with the knowledge needed to address the barriers and enablers that these communities face in relation to football. This knowledge will enable us to adapt current programs and tailor future programs, to address the barriers that prevent participation, but also focus on the enablers to maximise participation.
