SUBJECT: 2017 FFV GEELONG RULES OF COMPETITION & FEE SCHEDULE

Dear Clubs,

We wish to advise all FFV Geelong Clubs of the 2017 Rules of Competition and Fee Schedule.

In September we wrote to all Clubs providing information in relation to the review process regarding our Rules of Competition and Regulations and invited Clubs to provide us with feedback. As per previous seasons, throughout 2016 we also logged feedback and suggestions regarding our rules and processes received throughout the year. Additionally, FFV has collated information discussed at GRFC Meetings to ensure that all delegates from Clubs could provide feedback.

We have relied on the information obtained through the processes referred to above to review the documents below and make a number of changes. We have also made some further drafting changes to the Facilities Standards to streamline the venue classification of facilities for Community Football and remove references that are only applicable for NPL Competition. Standing Committee feedback was also sought with respect to proposed changes. Clubs should take the opportunity to familiar themselves with all Rules and Regulations. To assist with that process we have prepared a summary of the main changes made to the Geelong Rules and Regulations for 2017 (see link above).

The Fee Schedule has been adjusted for 2017. Whilst player and team registration fees have not changed, the total amount in the MiniRoos fee has been amended due to admin error. There have been some minor adjustments to the referee fees based on changes to 2017 leagues offered to clubs, as well as feedback provided by the GRFC. These fees have been reviewed in comparison to metropolitan competitions.
