Please note that teams that have changed leagues, or new team entries, will not appear in SportsTG until the publication of the Draft Fixture Release on Wednesday 29 March. During the period between now and the Draft Fixture Release, we ask that clubs refrain from editing any team names in SportsTG, as this can impact the fixture generation process for your club.

LATE TEAM REQUESTS - LATE TEAM ENTRY, TEAM WITHDRAWAL OR REQUEST TO CHANGE LEAGUES

Any requests for new teams, team withdrawals or league changes must be submitted via the '[Late Team Request](#)' form found online, please [click HERE](#). A late team withdrawal will be actioned immediately, however the relevant team entry fee will still apply and will not be refunded (no additional withdrawal fee will apply).

Any late new team entry requests or requests to change leagues will be actioned during the regrading period that commences on Tuesday 9 May, unless FFV determines otherwise. Requests may be actioned earlier if a BYE exists in the league that the team is moving into or in the event of a request to change leagues does not negatively impact the league they are coming from or to.
